

NCMGVA Delegate Position Description

Each Master Gardener Program representing a single county or multi-counties is entitled to one Delegate and one Alternate. The Delegate or Alternate is elected or appointed by the respective county/counties in which they serve. Delegates and Alternates are members of the NCMGVA Board of Directors.

Notification of Delegates/Alternate election or appointment should be provided to the President of NCMGVA so they may receive appropriate information of NCMGVA functions.

NCMGVA requirements for county delegate and alternates are as follows:

1. Be a NCMGVA dues paying member.
2. Be elected or appointed by their Master Gardener Program (single county or multi-county) in which they serve.
3. The alternate delegate may only vote in the absence of the delegate.
4. Be able to attend Board Meetings.
5. Be liaison between NCMGVA and county/counties.
6. Promote continuing membership in NCMGVA and recruit new NCMGVA members.
