NCEMGVA Outstanding Extension Master Gardener Volunteer Award Nomination Guidelines

I. Purpose

The Outstanding Extension Master Gardener Volunteer Award represents an opportunity for EMGVs to recognize their colleagues for outstanding service.

II. Award Rules

- Nominations may be submitted by an Extension staff member or an individual EMGV.
 The submission <u>must</u> be a made by a member or associate member of the NCEMGVA.
- Nominees must be (1) a certified EMGV, (2) a current member of the NCEMGVA,
 (3) have served a minimum of FIVE years, (4) be in good standing with their county
 EMGV Program, and (5) have accrued an exceptional number of volunteer hours in the previous calendar year or over their years of service.
- Nominations must be submitted with all information supplied by April 1st of the NCEMGVA Conference year.
- Nominations are evaluated by the Awards Committee and selections recommended to the Executive Committee for approval. Award recipients will be recognized at the NCEMGVA Conference and announced in the NCEMGVA Newsletter.
- The Nominator will be notified by May 1st. The Award Nominee, the Nominator, and/or a
 member of the county program MUST be present to accept the Award. The photo taken
 at the Conference will accompany the Press Release sent to the designated publication.
