



Here's the information that you'll need to gather for the 2022 Inspire Connect Empower Project Grant application form:

1. Email of NCEMGVA member submitting the application.
2. Your county or multi-county program (choose from the drop down menu)
3. Name of Agent or CED who has approved this project
4. Name, email, phone number, and member ID of each of the two NCEMGVA active, regular members who are submitting this project. You can find your member ID by logging into the NCEMGVA website at <https://ncemgva.org/> and clicking on the person icon after logging in to "view profile".
5. Name of the project
6. Description of the project. Please tell us about this project. Tell us a story of why this project is important to your community.
7. Your audience. Describe who your target audience members are. What do you know about this audience that demonstrates they will benefit from this project?
8. Impact. Please describe the impact that you expect this project to have on your target audience. How will you measure this? Over what period of time?
9. Priority. If you are only applying for one grant, enter the number 1 (highest priority). If your county is submitting multiple grant applications, each must be assigned a different priority. The county assigns the priority.
10. Grant category: Startup-2 years or 2+years (25+months), with no upper time limit.
11. Amount: You may apply for the full maximum amount in the grant category you chose above, or less than that amount.
12. What other funding sources does this project have? What are the amounts?
13. Agreements – Indicate yes or no to each one:
  - a. If your county receives funding for this project, do you agree to provide NCEMGVA with contact information that can be used to submit a local press release?
  - b. If your county receives funding for this project, do you agree to include NCEMGVA as a sponsor or source of funding in any publicity related to the project?
  - c. If your county receives funding for this project, do you agree to provide NCEMGVA with a follow up report at the six month and one year intervals, describing the impact of the project on the community?
